1. Tumoral Calcinosis

2. Metaplastic carcinoma (Spindle cell carcinoma)

3. Pernio (chilblains)

Caused by exposure to cold, damp conditions, especially in unacclimatized individual.

May be associated with connective tissue disease, esp. SLE.

Clinically: tender red to purple papules after cold exposure, often on acral skin, ears, and nose Micro: Superficial and deep perivascular dermatitis with lymphs and prominent peri-eccrine inflammation. Papillary dermal edema.

Spontaneously resolves in a couple weeks usually.

4. Sclerosing adenosis of the prostate
