1. Pseudoangiomatous Stromal Hyperplasia (PASH)
2. Sertoli only syndrome
3. Atherosclerosis and Acute Myocardial Infarction
4. Silicone lymphadenopathy (presumably after breast augmentation with silicone implants)
5. Metastatic squamous cell carcinoma (in this case HPV-positive, but you can't definitively tell that by morphology, though the non-keratinizing appearance and clinical presentation suggests that)
6. Myositis ossificans
7. Complete Hydatidiform Mole (Molar pregnancy)
8. Papillary thyroid carcinoma (with a tall cell component) in a background of lymphocytic thyroiditis
9. Recurrent nevus
10. Stasis dermatitis
11. Choroid plexus papilloma
12. Cholesterosis (Cholesterol polyp)
13. Strongyloides infection (parasite)
14. Lung adenocarcinoma (mostly acinar pattern)
15. Eosinophilic esophagitis
16. Nipple adenoma
17. Cystitis glandularis
18. Adenocarcinoma In Situ (AIS), HPV-associated
19. Granular cell tumor (with some pseudoepitheliomatous hyperplasia)
20. Prostatic adenocarcinoma, Acinar type, Gleason Grade 3+3=6 (grade group 1)
