1. Diabetic (lymphocytic) mastopathy
2. Clear cell cribriform hyperplasia
3. Arrhythmogenic right ventricular dysplasia/cardiomyopathy (ARVD)
4. Non-necrotizing granulomatous inflammation (probable sarcoidosis)
5. Metastatic squamous cell carcinoma (with cystic degeneration)
6. Herpes ulcer
7. Goblet cell adenocarcinoma
8. Paraganglioma ("carotid body tumor")
9. Combined Brenner tumor and Serous cystadenoma
10. Lung adenocarcinoma (seems to be mostly in situ/lepidic; possible focal acinar/invasive)
11. Cryptococcal meningitis
12. Giant cell tumor of bone
13. Biopsy site changes ("suture granuloma")
14. Balloon cell nevus
15. Invasive lobular carcinoma and lobular carcinoma in situ
16. Schistosomiasis (with lots of associated inflammation)
17. Gallbladder invasive adenocarcinoma
18. Benign endometrial polyp
19. Chorangioma
20. Warthin's Tumor
