1. 30-year-old female with an ovarian mass: **Serous Borderline Tumor**
2. An adrenal mass found at autopsy: **Myelolipoma**
3. Retroperitoneal mass in a 70-year-old man: **Well-differentiated Liposarcoma**
4. Breast Mass: **Invasive Lobular Carcinoma and LCIS**
5. Anal erythema: **Extra-mammary Paget’s Disease**
6. Colon Mass (s/p biopsy): **Well-differentiated Neuroendocrine Tumor**
7. 60-year-old man with hematuria. Bladder lesion: **Schistosomiasis and Squamous Cell Carcinoma**
8. Lung Mass: **Invasive Adenocarcinoma**
9. 70-year-old man with a shoulder mass: **Spindle Cell Lipoma**
10. Nasal mass in a 13-year-old boy: **Juvenile Angiofibroma**
11. Oral Cavity Mass: **Mucoepidermoid Carcinoma, Low-grade**
12. Cystic Liver Mass: **Mucinous Cystic Neoplasm**
13. Oral lesion: **Foreign Material and Foreign Body Giant Cell Reaction (Pulse granuloma)**
14. Fallopian tube mass: **Ectopic Pregnancy**

16. 12-year-old boy with a cerebellar mass: **Pilocytic Astrocytoma**

19. Non-blanching purplish red purpura: **Leukocytoclastic Vasculitis**
